

WHAT DOES IT TAKE TO BE SUCCESSFUL IN SUMMER SCHOOL?

If you are motivated, organized, and can follow a timeline, you should successfully achieve your goal for summer school. Remember that you have from the time of registration, to July 22 (exams written by 23rd), to complete your course.

SUMMER SCHOOL FEES

If you were 19 years of age or under on September 1, 2018, fees are: **\$125.00**

If you were 20 years of age or older on September 1, 2018, fees are:
\$100 per credit (core courses \$500)

Registration will not proceed until fees are paid in full.

Withdrawal refunds will not be issued for DL courses.

Note: You may write your final exam when courses are successfully completed and all textbooks have been returned.

QUESTIONS ABOUT SUMMER SCHOOL

WHEN IS SUMMER SCHOOL?

Registrations are accepted between May 1 and June 25, 2018. You may begin your course upon registration. **All coursework must be completed by July 23.** July 22 and 23 are test-writing days only. Marks will be submitted to Alberta Education on July 25, 2019.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Call VPHS to schedule an appointment with an administrator. Pick-up or download the registration package. Complete the forms and bring them along with your school fees, birth certificate, statement of marks, and current report card.

**Fees must be paid in full with cash or cheque at time of registration.*

CAN I TAKE MORE THAN ONE CLASS?

Usually you can take one core class in the summer however, an appropriate course load and schedule will be developed at the intake meeting.

WHAT IS THE METHOD OF INSTRUCTION?

All courses are completed with Distributed Learning materials, with one-on-one teacher support as needed. Schedules for exams and assignments are developed at registration. All marking is done on-site, with timely feedback.



WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T FINISH MY COURSE BY JULY 23?

The intention is that all summer school courses be completed in the timeframe provided upon intake. Unless alternative arrangements have been made prior to the start of summer school, a final mark will be submitted on July 26 for all summer school courses. If during summer school you realize you need additional time to continue with the course in the fall, make an appointment to meet with an administrator at VPHS immediately to make these arrangements. Remember, if you need the summer class as a prerequisite for a course you'll be starting in September, you must have finished the course by July 23rd.
