WHEN IS SUMMER SCHOOL?

Registrations will be accepted between May 1 and June 25, 2020. Classes begin Monday, June 29, and end Thursday, July 23. Classes run Monday to Thursday 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. Students have access to tutorial time from 1:00 pm-3:00 pm on those days.
